- > The budget was ratified.

- > Tom Herrod declined to run again for his position.
- > Debra asked if there were any nominations from the floor.
- > Craig Gelckman was nominated.
- > Motion to close nomination was duly made, seconded and passed unanimously.
- > <u>Motion</u> to elect Katrina Parks, Debbie Osborne and Craig Gleckman for 3-year terms by acclamation was duly made, seconded and passed unanimously.

Homeowner Forum:

- > Maintenance issues related to gutter cleaning were raised. It was suggested that more supervision of the selected contractor was needed.
- > There was discussion about the amount of dog waste on the property and the frustration with those that do not take care of their pets.
- Questions about why nothing has been done to the tennis court. Debra provided a summary of the process to make a Declaration change to repurpose the courts.

- > Budget questions were asked and answered.
- > There was an inquiry as what services CPMG provides as the management company.
